In celebration of the 5th Anniversary of the Art of Giving, San Beda University joined the global movement of spreading love through a feeding activity last May 17, 2018. Under the guidance of the University's Rector-President Rev. Fr. Aloysius Ma. A. Maranan, OSB, the activity was spearheaded by the Institutional Community Involvement Center and the Linkages and International Affairs office in partnership with the San Beda College Benedictine Educational Foundation, Inc. With the assistance of the St. John of God Center, SBU was able to feed 48 street children aged 3 months to 14 years old, around Quiapo area with rice, chicken adobo, boiled egg and apple. Aside from the rice and viand, the children were also given food packs containing milk and biscuits. A total of 27 students, employees and faculty volunteered and shared their time during the activity. The "Feeding with Love" activity served as a concrete expression of the Benedictine Value of Hospitality and Community as the Bedan participants served the street children with joy and fulfillment.
